Detailed instructions for accessing and using the PDF eXpress site:

Important:

After proofreading and checking your paper with IEEE PDF eXpress, it must be submitted electronically through the DDECS 2009 Paper Submission, using the **PDF format**.

Access the IEEE PDF eXpress site.

First-time IEEE PDF eXpress users:

- a. Click "New Users Click Here"
- b. Enter **ddecs2009** for the Conference ID, your e-mail address, and choose a new password; Continue to enter information as prompted.
- c. You will receive online and e-mail confirmation of successful account setup.

Previous users, but using it for the first time for a new conference:

- Enter ddecs2009 for the Conference ID, your e-mail address, and enter the password you used for your old account
- b. When you click "Login", you'll receive an error saying you need to set up an account. Simply click "Continue". By entering your previously used e-mail address and password combination, you will enable your old account for access to this new conference
- c. Check that the contact information is still valid, and click "Submit"
- d. You will receive online and e-mail confirmation of successful account setup.

Returning users:

- a. Enter ddecs2009 for the Conference ID, e-mail address and password
- 2. For each conference paper, click "Create New Title".
- 3. Enter identifying text for paper (title is recommended but not required).
- 4. Click "Submit PDF for Checking" or "Submit Source Files for Conversion".
- 5. Indicate platform, source file type (if applicable), click Browse and navigate to file, and click "Upload File". You will receive online and e-mail confirmation of successful upload.
- You will receive an e-mail with your Checked PDF or IEEE PDF eXpressconverted PDF attached. If you submitted a PDF for Checking, the e-mail will show if your file passed or failed.

If the submitted PDF fails the check:

- a. Submit your source file for conversion by clicking <u>Try Again</u>, the <u>Submit Source Files for</u> Conversion, or
- b. Read the PDF Check report, then click "The PDF Check Report" in the sidebar to get information on possible solutions, or
- c. "Request Technical Help" through your account.

If you are not satisfied with the IEEE PDF eXpress-converted PDF:

- Resubmit your source file with corrections (<u>Try Again</u>, then <u>Submit Source Files for Conversion</u>), or
- b. Submit a PDF by clicking **Try Again**, then **Submit PDF for Checking**, or
- c. "Request a Manual Conversion" through your account.

If the PDF submitted passed the PDF Check, or you are satisfied with your IEEE PDF eXpress-converted PDF:

a. Submit your IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF to the WCCI 2008 Online Paper Submission site.

IEEE PDF eXpress converts the following application formats to PDF:

- Microsoft Word
- WordPerfect
- Rich Text Format
- Freelance
- (La)TeX (a DVI and supported image files must be included in a compressed archive)
- PageMaker (images should not be embedded, included with main file in a compressed archive)
- FrameMaker
- Word Pro
- Quark (*.qxd and images files must be included in a compressed archive)

DDECS 2009 has registered for use of a IEEE PDF eXpress. IEEE PDF eXpress is a free service to IEEE conferences that allows their authors to make IEEE Xplore-compatible PDFs (Conversion Function) or to check PDFs that authors have made themselves for IEEE eXpress compatibility (PDF Check function). *Prior to* submitting your camera-ready paper to the conference web site, please check acceptability of your paper at IEEE PDF eXpress as described above.
